Ex.) BOG¹ GB² SM57³ 1inch⁴ off⁵ 1⁶.wav

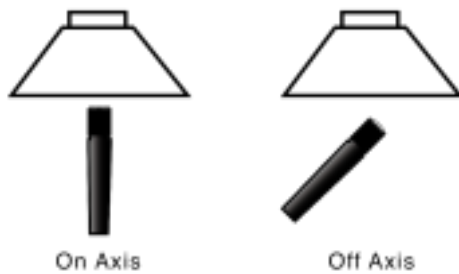

- ① The name of the cabinet.
- ② The name of the speaker unit.
- ③ The name of the microphone.
- ④ The distance from the amplifier grill cloth to the microphone.

The on/off axis of the microphone placement.



⑥ The serial number of the microphone placement. The smaller number is close to the center cap and the larger number is close to the cone edge.
